2012 CABERNET SAUVIGNON **BARREL SELECTION**

From the Mosquito Creek vineyard at Joanna, (Wrattonbully Region), in the South East of South Australia, where we have produced high quality Cabernets for over 25 years.

From the fantastic 2012 vintage we have selected only the very best barrels to produce a wine to rival our multi-award winning Cabernets from previous vintages over a long period.

Our first barrel selection cabernet since 2008, and early tastings indicate the 2012 will equal the award winning 2008 and 2002 vintages in quality and longevity.

A low yielding crop, the grapes are from the classic 'terra rossa over limestone soil', hand picked, controlled ferment and aged for nearly 2 years in seasoned and new French oak barrels.

Still very new, the wine is one to cellar, where it will develop and mature significantly with bottle age to a full bodied wine with intense berry fruit flavours and an elegant, smooth finish. Drink up to 2022.
